

Acknowledgement Statements

The following acknowledgment statements are mandatory for all registrants in order to attend convention. Please read each statement carefully before completing the registration process.

Photography Release

***I understand and acknowledge that FWATA has my permission to use my, my guest's/child's photograph. I understand that the images may be used by FWATA in print publications, online publications, presentations, websites, and social media. I also understand that no royalty, fee or other compensation shall become payable to me by reason of such use.**

Convention Attire and Name Badges

*

We strongly encourage participants to dress in a manner befitting professionals while attending educational sessions, special sessions, special events and the exhibit hall. Business casual – dress shirts/blouses, slacks, skirts and footwear (no jeans or shorts) is the recommended attire.

Learning Lab participants should wear lab attire (something comfortable you can move freely in) for the Learning Lab and return to business casual afterwards.

To help ensure the safety of all attendees, convention name badges must be worn and visible at all times while attending convention sessions and events. Convention access will be denied if an attendee does not have their convention name badge. Replacement name badges will cost \$10.

Guest Name Badges Required

*

I understand and acknowledge that upon check-in, adult guests and children 12+ and older who wish to attend the Guest Approved Events* must obtain a convention badge.

****Guests and children of registered attendees may attend the Welcome Reception and FWATA Awards Banquet (additional tickets must be purchased for each guest and/or child). The Exhibit Hall is open to adult guests, children 12 and older, and infants during unrestricted hours only. Strollers are not allowed on the show floor at any time. Children must be accompanied by an adult registrant at all times.***

Guest and Children Access Restrictions

***I understand and acknowledge that all guests (including children and infants) are not permitted to attend any educational programming. Only program speakers may submit requests for the consideration of their adult guests (18 years and older) by contacting the programming chair, prior to the start of the Annual Meeting and Clinical Symposium.**

Alcohol and Other Substances Notification

*

This is a friendly reminder from the Far West Athletic Trainers' Association (FWATA) that the legal age for consuming, purchasing and possessing alcohol and other controlled substances in the state of Nevada is 21 years of age.

It is also illegal for adults 21 years of age or older to procure minors (under the age of 21 years) with alcohol or other controlled substances. By registering for this event, you and your family and guests acknowledge that you have been made aware of the legal age in the state of Nevada and that the Westgate Las Vegas Resort and Casino and the Far West Athletic Trainers' Association are not responsible for any attendees who are in violation of these, or any other, state laws.
